Here are just a few examples:

- ENERGY STAR qualified high-efficiency natural gas furnaces are at least 12% more efficient than conventional models.
- ENERGY STAR qualified televisions use about 30% less energy (when in standby mode) than standard TV sets.
- ENERGY STAR qualified dishwashers are at least 33% more efficient than required by the Government of Canada's Energy Efficiency Regulations.
- ENERGY STAR qualified residential light fixtures use about 67% less energy than conventional fixtures.
- ENERGY STAR qualified computers use 70% less electricity than typical models without power-management features. These features set the computer in low-power mode when the computer is left inactive.
